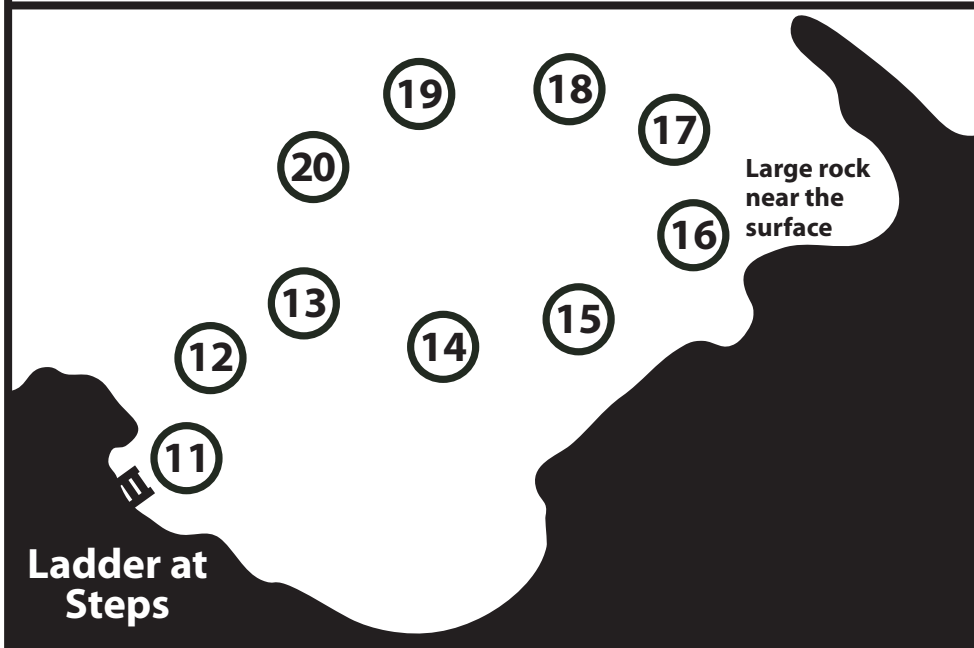


# LEMON VALLEY

Likely fish to be encountered: **Bastard Cavalley Pilot, Bastard Hogfish, Bullseye, Cavalley Pilot, Conger, Cunningfish, Fivefinger, Grannyfish, Greenfish, Grouper, Gurnard, Hardback Soldier, Hogfish, Parrotfish, Rockfish, Rockspear, Soapfish, Shitty Trooper, Softback Soldier, Trantran**

Other marine life to encounter: **Starfish, sea urchins, sea cucumber, sea worm, algae, coral, feather stars**
