St Helena Island is open! From 8 August, the island has dropped its COVID-19 entry restrictions. This means that upon arrival:

- No quarantine requirements
- No testing requirements

vaccinated upon arrival.

- No mask-wearing requirements
- No vaccination requirements

Mask-wearing may still be required by individual businesses and within certain 'COVID-free zones' such as the General Hospital.

In certain cases, if symptomatic and/or needing medical attention, testing and isolation may be requested.

While the rest of the world has long since adapted to living with COVID-19, however, St Helena has not. Prior to August, our small and isolated community (4,200) had never worn masks, never had to practice social distancing and never truly been exposed to the virus. Living with COVID-19 is new to us. Weekly flights to resume



From 8 October 2022, the weekly Johannesburg-St Helena Airlink flights that were paused during the pandemic will be reinstated. This service will include a monthly return flight with Ascension Island.

The reopening of the 30-room Mantis St Helena – the island's only luxury, boutique hotel – is planned for 15 October 2022 to go alongside the resumption of weekly flights.
